An Outstanding Doctor!!!

- **Prof. Dr. Gustavo Zubieta-Calleja**

Dr. M.S. Biradar had a charming and kind smile, an intelligent gaze, and a willingness to help and contribute to the advancement of science always on behalf of BLDE Deemed to be University. The minute we met him, we realized we were with an extraordinary man, physician, Vice-Chancellor. We later learned that he had started in an humble setting but rose to the highest places in Academia. A self-made man, he was a pillar of progress and scientific advance and would have, without any doubt, taken his Institution to the highest Indian and international levels. Sadly, he left us all, leaving behind an emptiness that tore the hearts of all those that admired, learned from him, and loved him.

On July 10th, 2016, on the 46th celebration of our High Altitude Pulmonary and Pathology Institute (HAPPI-IPPA), we initiated a grand chronic hypoxia scientific tour throughout India by the invitation of Prof. Thuppil Venkatesh, "The Lead Man of India". Around two months before our visit, I received a letter from Prof. Kusal Das, director of the Laboratory of Vascular Physiology & Medicine, Department of Physiology, Shri B.M. Patil Medical college and BLDE Deemed to be University. When I told him that I would be going to India to give talks, he kindly invited me to visit BLDE Deemed To Be University and present my work. As we

arrived with Prof. Venkatesh, we had an excellent reception where we first met the distinguished Dean and Principal, Dr. M.S. Biradar (at the time), and the former Vice-Chancellor Prof. B.G. Muliman, Prof. Biradar's smile, kindness, and sincere gaze deeply struck me. I immediately knew I was in front of a unique man.

The conferences gave us the chance to interact. He was very sharp, a quick thinker, and prompt to respond with a positive attitude. His love for science was evident and recomforting, as this was the initial encounter that would carry us through exciting scientific roads. His noteworthy academic and high social intelligence had evidently taken him to this distinguished position. As I look back at the pictures of my visit, the pleasant memories of his captivating laugh, deep sincerity, and excellent self-confidence earned more admiration. That is how a man should be! We became wonderful friends, and it lasted forever.

Every two years, we organize the Chronic Hypoxia Symposia here in Bolivia. The 4th was carried out in New Delhi, in association with the Global Hypoxia Summit. I invited Prof. Biradar and Prof. Kusal Das to co-organize on behalf of BLDE our 7th Chronic Hypoxia Symposium from Feb 23rd to Mar 2nd, 2019. They both arrived in La Paz at around 1:00 am and I received them at the airport of El Alto at 4,100m, the highest airport in the world. With their presence, they blessed our Symposium. Unfortunately, they could only stay for three days. Still, Prof. Biradar played a fundamental role representing BLDE Deemed to be University during the inauguration held at the auditorium of the Bolivian Navy headquarters. Prof. Venkatesh had brought a multiple candles stand for the illumination ceremony at the opening of the Symposium, being a first in Bolivia, honoring India for its magnificent culture. Distinguished scientists from 16 countries attended this unique Symposium. As usual, it started in the city of La Paz at 3,600m above sea level and many high altitude areas

where the itinerant meeting is carried out. On this occasion, I was able to know Prof. Biradar more profoundly. My admiration for him grew exponentially as time passed by. I interacted with the Academic and became aware of his extensive knowledge in internal medicine. His observations during the Symposium were sound, logical, and inspiring. The words fall short to describe him adequately, I can only express my sincere thoughts about his impression on me.

On my next trip to give talks in India, I had the fortune of spending more time with him and Prof. Kusal Das. I particularly recall the last visit to his office, where my daughter Natalia and I had a long conversation with him. Alas, I discovered his philosophical facet and also his love for nature. The world needs physicians like him, and his tragic loss is a major loss for all of us.

I deeply regret that he left us with the terrible COVID pandemic, which I presume resulted from his total dedication to helping others survive of it, taking away his sleep linked to a non-stopping urge to collaborate efficiently. He truly devoted his life for his work and the people that came to seek his help. We had the honour of writing a memorial with his photos that will always remain as an important part of our Institution over 16,000 Km away, 3,500m higher in altitude from here on to eternity!
